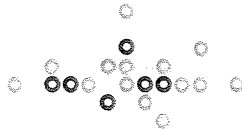

Dear Ms Dortch:

In accordance with 47 CFR 73.561 (d), Minnesota Public Radio ("MPR"), licensee of WGGL-FM, Houghton, MI, hereby informs the Commission that as of September 15, 2009 WGGL is operating at 85% of its authorized power. The cause of the problem is the failure of a tube. Parts and repairs of the tube are anticipated to take more than 10 days.

All reasonable efforts will be made to replace the damaged equipment and get the station back up to its authorized power as soon as possible.

An Anti-Drug Abuse Act certification form is attached. MPR is a noncommercial educational licensee, therefore, no fee is required for this filing.
