Approval of 2008-09 School Calendar Adjustments

Due to cancellation of school on March 25-27 and March 30-April 3 as a a result of blizzards and epic flooding in the area, the administrative recommendation is to make the following adjustments to the 2008-09 School Calendar:

Friday, June 5

Last Day for K-12 Students

Tuesday, June 9

Last Scheduled Day for K-12 Staff

Information from the Minnesota Department of Education states that there is no provision in state law that calls for a reduction in state aid if a district does not provide instruction to students for a certain number of days. Under state law, local school boards set the calendar and determine whether canceled days should be made up at a later date.

Our district has a strong commitment to student learning and this recommendation recognizes the need to make up instructional time as well as allow for weather emergencies.

In total, students have missed 11 days of school for the 2008-09 school year. Three student days will be made up (January 2, June 4, June 5). It is important to have the remainder of the school year focused on academic activities. Staff will make up an additional two days (June 8 and 9). If more days are missed due to emergency conditions, the recommendation is to provide flexibility to make up the time through professional activities for staff.

Suggested Resolution: Move to approve 2008-09 School Calendar adjustments as presented.
